Agenda Item: Consider award of Engineering Services During Construction contract for Power Monitoring Upgrade Project

Objective: Seek Board authorization for award of Engineering Services During Construction (ESDC) for the Power Monitoring Upgrade project.

Background: The District advertises for Statement of Qualifications (SOQs) annually and retains SOQs on file for two years. The District draws from its on-file SOQs to assist with projects. On July 31, a selection committee met to choose a firm to assist with value engineering for the Power Monitoring Upgrade. The selection committee rated firms in three weighted categories: firm qualifications (40%), individual qualifications (40%) and reference checks (20%). Brown and Caldwell was the preferred firm for this work.

Brown and Caldwell provided additional bid services related to the Power Monitoring Upgrade under their value engineering scope. District staff is pleased with the communication and attention to detail provided by Brown and Caldwell and requested a scope and fee to provide ESDC for the construction phase of the project. These services are anticipated to cost \$81,950.00 for phase I activities.

Committee Activity: This project was discussed with the Engineering Committee on August 28 and November 1. Engineering Committee recommends the ESDC contract be awarded to Brown & Caldwell.

Recommendation: Staff recommends Brown and Caldwell for ESDC on the Power Monitoring Upgrade project - Phase I for \$81,950.00.
