



***Resolution of Appreciation  
To  
Arthur D. Hunter***

By motion duly made, seconded, and carried by unanimous and enthusiastic vote, the Board of Trustees of the Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake & Sandy, meeting on May 20, 2019, in a duly convened regular session, adopted the following resolution, to wit:

**WHEREAS**, Art Hunter has faithfully served on the Board of Trustees of the Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake & Sandy from October 2014 through April 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, Art served as a member of the Board of this District for five years, serving on both the Management Advisory and Finance Committees for five years, and Chair of the Finance Committee for nearly two years, and in those capacities played an important role in this District's budgeting process, rating agency reviews, and refinancing strategies, which resulted in significant savings to the District and its member cities; and provided invaluable leadership regarding District employee benefits and personnel policies; and

**WHEREAS**, Art was employed by Sandy City from March 1971 to June 2014. That employment was interrupted for the two years he served in the military. During his distinguished career at Sandy City, Art held the positions of City Treasurer, City Recorder, Director of Finance, Administrative Services Director, and Director of Finance and Information Services; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to his service on the District's Board, Art's civic service included: (i) service as a Director of the Provo River Water Users Association; (ii) service on the Sandy City Public Utilities Advisory Board; (iii) service on the Private Activity Bond Authority; (iv) service on the State Auditor's Committees for the drafting of the Uniform Fiscal Procedures Act for Cities and Towns and the drafting of the Uniform Fiscal Procedures Act for Special Districts; (v) extended service on the Sandy Pride Committee, including two years as that committee's Chair; (vi) service as one of the founding members of the Utah Finance Officers Association and service as the Secretary/Treasurer and later President of that Association, as well as the Utah Representative to the National Association of Finance Officers; and (vii) service on the Organizing Committee of the Utah Risk Management Mutual Association.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Trustees of the Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake & Sandy hereby expresses its deepest gratitude to Art Hunter for his many contributions to the Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake & Sandy, and for his dedication with excellence to its goals and purposes.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board of Trustees places great value and esteem on its professional association with Art Hunter and hereby expresses its most sincere appreciation for his many years of service to this District and its residents and to the State of Utah.
