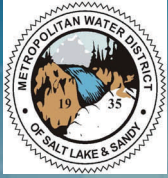

## DISTRICT TRAINING IN FULL SWING

The District's Project Engineers, Aqueduct Inspectors, General Manager and Engineering Manager were involved in a half day training on Professional Presentation Skills. The objective of the training was to prepare staff to communicate in a professional and confident manner to the public that resides along the aqueduct corridor. Participants were able to role play different scenarios involving interactions with the public.

With the upcoming inspection of the Salt Lake Aqueduct in Provo Canyon, several employees attended the Confined Space Training taught by Eric Sorensen and Jeff Matheson in the Environmental Services Department. Employees were required to participate in hands on training in order to help them be better prepared in an emergency.

Annalee Munsey attended a 5 week Fundamentals of Human Resource Management course taught by the Employer's Council. As well, she has been attending evening classes taught by Utah State University Business Management faculty to prepare herself to take the Professional in Human Resources exam in December.

On October 14th and 28th, the Cottonwood Heights Police Department held training sessions for their certified law enforcement professionals at the Little Cottonwood Water Treatment Plant. The training consisted of a tour of the Little Cottonwood Water Treatment Plant, as well as, class training to familiarize themselves with the facilities at the treatment plant. Approximately forty certified law enforcement officers attended the training, twenty per session. Tours were conducted by Claudia Wheeler, Nathan Scown, and Bret Goodwin.

## INSTALLATION OF LEAK DETECTION SYSTEM AT RAW WATER RESERVOIR

The Point of the Mountain Water Treatment Plant (POMWTP) raw water reservoir dam/embankment has a sump and piezometer leak detection monitoring system which is powered by a solar panel. This system has malfunctioned several times due to lack of sunlight, high temperatures, and equipment failures. In an effort to solve the power supply problem, the District's Instrumentation & Electrical (I&E) group has installed conduit and pulled wire from a constant power source to the leak detection monitoring system panel. This supply of constant power to the system panel has eliminated the instability associated with the solar panel power system. Additionally, I&E has insulated the system panel which has decreased the temperature of the panel in the summer by about fifteen degrees. These changes should improve the reliability and life expectancy of this system, allowing the District to provide good data to the Dam Safety Section of the state Division of Water Rights.

## UPGRADE TO DISTRICT'S EMAIL SERVER

The Information Technology group recently migrated and upgraded the District's email server to a new system that is located in a more secure environment. The recent upgrade also included updating the email system to the latest software version. This newer version of the software will add improved security capabilities and increase the stability and reliability of the email system. An additional benefit of this new email system is that it allows District employees to be more connected to their email, helping them to be more responsive and productive.
