**Agenda Item:** Public Hearing

**Background:** An area known as the River Oaks subdivision (approximately 1600 East Creek Road) is currently within Sandy City boundaries (paying taxes to MWDSL) while being provided water service by Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District. In January 2009, MWDSL agreed with Sandy City to proceed with the de-annexation process. On January 11, 2010 the Board approved resolution 1836 which initiated the withdrawal process of the River Oaks subdivision.

MWDSL is required to hold a public hearing related to the withdrawal no later than 90 days following the resolution. Notices of the public hearing were mailed to each registered voter within the area proposed to be withdrawn and notices were posted in four conspicuous places within the areas to be withdrawn. The Public Hearing will be held on February 22, 2010 at 6:00 PM for the purpose of allowing the public to ask questions and obtain further information about the proposed withdrawal and issues raised by it; and any interested person to address the board of trustees concerning the proposed withdrawal.

Following the public hearing, the board on March 22, 2010 will consider another resolution to approve or reject the de-annexation. It is anticipated that the process will be complete sometime in May or June.

The Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake & Sandy is a local district that was formed in 1935 with the objective to acquire and develop water supply for the Salt Lake Valley. The District provides drinking water supply primarily to Salt Lake City and Sandy City. The District is citizen-administered through a Board of Trustees comprised of seven board members which serve four year terms. Five of the Trustees are appointed by the Salt Lake City Council and two Trustees are appointed by the Sandy City Council.
